



Department of Family and Community Services* Operating Budget Comparison FY2022-FY2024 (in thousands)







Alaska Pioneer Homes Operating Budget Comparison FY2022-FY2024 (in thousands)





- Assist offenders and their families in developing skills to prevent crime.


