



FY23 School District Expenditure Budget by Category Student






Priority Funding for Public Education



- Early and predictable funding is crucial
- ➤ Flat funding & 40 year high inflation = unsustainable loss of purchasing power
- >> 1% BSA Increase FY24 to implement the Alaska Reads Act


How BSA Flat Funding is affecting our schools

How BSA Flat Funding is affecting our schools



- > Fixed Cost Increases
 - Utilities i.e, energy
 - Insurance costs (health, liability, ect.)
 - Transportation
 - Classroom materials
- > 8% inflation in 2022
- Cuts have been made in schools to continue safe operations

Costs of Turnover



- ➤ ISER Study 2017
 - Every time Alaska replaces a teacher, it costs the school district over \$20,000
- > RAND Study 2019
 - Average cost to replace a principal is \$75,000

- + Teacher Turnover



Costs of Turnover



According to the American Journal of Education

- Students achieve less in math and reading during first year after leader turnover
- Year-after-year turnover creates cumulative negative effects

What can be done to improve school funding?
