## **Analysis**

HB62 extends the effective date of the Renewable Energy Grant Fund and recommendation program to June 30, 2033.
The Alaska Energy Authority has budget authority of \$1,401.2 in the FY2024 Governor operating budget for ongoing administrative costs for the Renewable Energy Grant Fund. Extending the Renewable Energy Grant Fund does not create additional costs for the Alaska Energy Authority.
