Analysis

This bill requires the Alaska Court System to create a Driving While Under the Influence diversion program and sets the guidelines for the program.

If passed, Section 8 amends Alaska Statute 28.15.151(a) and requires the Division of Motor Vehicles to maintain a file of every diversion agreement entered by proposed Alaska Statute 28.35.043.

The division believes that the bill's implementation will not result in any financial changes and will have minimal operational impact and therefore submits a zero fiscal note.
