My name is Donna Anderson. I am a recently retired KPBSD teacher. Tonight I speak from that experience as a concerned stakeholder.

I oppose HB 69. This bill has zero accountability attached to it. This bill asks for a blank check increase of \$1800 to the BSA. In 2015 DEED wrote a resolution in support of repealing the 70/30 rule. One of the reasons listed as rationale for repealing the 70/30 rule was "Stakeholders will provide oversight to the budget." The public stakeholders have made it clear that they want results and they want accountability. NEA makes it clear they support the blank check, money grab, goodbye PFD approach outlined in this bill.

On Friday, Governor Dunleavy introduced HB 76 and SB 82 to improve educational outcomes for all Alaska students. This comprehensive plan focuses on funding, student achievement, and expanding opportunities for families and educators statewide. HB 76 and SB 82 align with the Education Reform Data Survey that shows "Education spending alone isn't the answer." The 2021 DEEDS Teacher Retention Survey shows the #1 area that impacts teacher retainment and retention is salary.

The blank check approach to school funding disenfranchises the public as well as teachers. These are the families who are leaving public schools and choosing to homeschool. These are the teachers, like myself, who leave the classroom. Its simple cause and effect. Decrease in student enrollment causes a decrease in, and need for, funding.

The blank check approach gives this board freedom to approve 8.9%-12% raises for central office staff, along with multiple \$9000 bonuses for some. According to "Open the Books" this amounts to between \$20,000-50,000 pay raise for some central office administrators. Alaska families are paying multiple superintendents more than we pay our Governor.

The blank check approach allows the repeated wasteful spending of millions of dollars on curriculum and materials.

Your responsibility is to the families and students, the stakeholders, who reside in the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District, and not to NEA. As the Union converges on Juneau with their red shirts blazing, I hope you remember the stakeholders at home who are rightfully demanding accountability and results. If KPBSD does not make the necessary internal changes to attract and retain families and teachers, you will continue to see families choosing other options for educating their children. You will continue to see good teachers leave the profession.

I ask that you oppose HB 69. I ask for your support for HB 76 and SB 82. This comprehensive approach to educational reform is a step away from status quo and a step toward building trust between KPBSD and the stakeholders who choose to reside and educate their children here. HB 76 and SB82 align with the will of the people, asking for accountability and results. It also addresses the need for quality teacher recruitment and retention, both which have a direct impact on student outcomes.
