7 (1) certification of a person who meets the training and other
8 requirements as an emergency medical technician, emergency medical technician
9 instructor, or emergency medical dispatcher;

10 (2) authorization for an emergency medical technician certified under
11 this chapter to provide under the written or oral direction of a physician the advanced
12 life support services enumerated on the certificate or enumerated on a written
13 document filed with the department by the technician's medical director and approved
14 by the department under its regulations;

15 (3) certification that a person, organization, or government agency that
16 provides an emergency medical service, conducts a training course for a mobile
17 intensive care paramedic, or represents itself as a trauma center meets the minimum
18 standards prescribed by the department for that service, course, or designation;

19 (4) authorization for an emergency medical service certified under this
20 chapter to provide under the written or oral direction of a physician the advanced life
21 support services enumerated on the certificate or enumerated on a written document
22 filed with the department by the medical director for the emergency medical service
23 and approved by the department under its regulations; [AND]

1 (5) licensure of a mobile intensive care paramedic and the medical
2 services that a mobile intensive care paramedic may perform, including the

3 (A) educational and other qualifications, which may include
4 education in pain management and opioid use and addiction;

5 (B) application and licensing procedures;

6 (C) scope of activities authorized; and

7 (D) responsibilities of a supervising or training physician; and

8 **(6) authorization for an emergency medical technician certified**
9 **under this chapter or mobile intensive care paramedic licensed under this**
10 **chapter to provide to operational canines the emergency medical services**
11 **enumerated on a written document filed with the department by the medical**
12 **director and approved by the department in regulation.**"

6 issued under AS 08.98.186, except that a person may perform functions authorized by

7 (1) regulation of the board if the person is licensed as a veterinary
8 technician; [OR]

9 (2) a permit issued under AS 08.02.050 if the person is employed by
10 an agency that has a permit issued under AS 08.02.050; or

11 (3) AS 18.08.093 if the person is certified as an emergency medical
12 technician or licensed as a mobile intensive care paramedic."
