FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. SB 73

Analysis

This bill modifies Alaska’s marijuana tax structure by reducing the excise tax on marijuana sales from \$50 per ounce to \$12 per ounce, a 76% decrease. These changes will reduce overall state revenue from marijuana taxation, impacting funds allocated to various state programs, including the Department of Public Safety (DPS) Council on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault (CDVSA) grant programs.

Fiscal Impact Analysis for the Council on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault

AS 43.61.010(c) provides for 50 percent of marijuana tax collect to be deposited into the recidivism reduction fund. AS 43.61.010(d) allows the legislature to use the annual estimated balance in the recidivism reduction fund to make appropriations to the Department of Corrections, the Department of Health, and the Department of Public Safety.

To estimate fiscal impact of SB 73, the Department of Public Safety (DPS) made assumptions based on the FY26 appropriation of the recidivism reduction fund between the three departments and tax projections from the Department of Revenue (DOR). The \$13,000.0 FY2026 DOR Total Fund Revenue projection is anticipated to be appropriated between the three departments for FY26. The DPS share of that \$13,000.0 is \$1,617.5, or 12.4% of the total FY26 appropriation. Then, DPS used the DOR change in revenue fiscal analysis for HB 73 relevant to fund 1246, recidivism reduction fund.
