

CHAPTER 11

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$440,000 for transportation of school children in the biennium ending June 30, 1959; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 14)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$440,000, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the transportation of school pupils in the State for the biennium ending June 30, 1959. This Appro-

priation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for transportation of school pupils during said biennium.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 12

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$23,107.00 out of the General Fund not otherwise appropriated to carry out the provisions of Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 44)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. **Appropriation.** The sum of \$23,107.00 is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated to carry out the provisions of Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2 of the First State Legislature, First Session, an Act to author-

ize the purchase of certain legislative copying, duplicating and collating equipment.

Sec. 2. **Effective Date.** This Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 13

AN ACT

Authorizing the payment of certain bounty claims not exceeding \$1,050.00 from funds appropriated by committee substitute for house bill no. 22 and authorizing the treasurer to pay them regardless of other provisions of law; further providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 47)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The state treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the following sixteen (16) named persons the amounts

set opposite their names, the total not to exceed one thousand fifty dollars (\$1,050.00), from the amount of one hundred and seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$107,500.00) appropriated

by means of committee substitute for house bill number twenty-two (22) for present and anticipated 1958-1959 fiscal year deficiency:

Sec. 2. The Legislature hereby finds after investigation by the House Finance Committee that the above bounty claims are bona fide and in substantial compliance with state law although technically they could not be certified for payment by the treasurer. Future claims for bounties must strictly conform to state law.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 14

AN ACT

To appropriate funds for the payment of bounty deficiencies; and providing for an effective date.

(C.S.H.B. 22)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are hereby appropriated for present and anticipated 1958-1959 fiscal year deficiency:

BOUNTY CLAIMS: DEFICIENCIES

Wolf and coyote claims ..	\$55,000.00
Wolverine claims	7,500.00
Hair seal claims	45,000.00
TOTAL	\$107,500.00

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.

CHAPTER 15

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$1,500.00 for examination expenses of the Real Estate Commission for the biennium ending June 30, 1959; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 6)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$1,500.00 is hereby appropriated out of any monies
