

CHAPTER 36

AN ACT

Relating to the taking of herring spawn; amending Sec. 1, Ch. 34, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date.

(S.B. 187)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 34, SLA 1959 is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. No person, firm, association, organization or corporation shall take herring spawn in waters on or over any lands or tidelands owned or hereafter acquired by the State of Alaska nor shall any person, firm, association, organization or corporation engage in the sale, barter, or exchange

of herring spawn for profit; provided, however, that herring spawn may be taken for personal use or, upon the securing of a permit from the commissioner of fish and game, may be taken for commercial purposes at places and times and in such amounts and manner as may be permitted by the board of fish and game.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or upon the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 37

AN ACT

Relating to the incorporation of first class cities; amending Sec. 16-1-4, ACLA 1949; and providing for an effective date.

(S.B. 205)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Sec. 16-1-4, ACLA 1949, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-1-4. **Order Adjudging and Declaring Incorporation: Filing Same.** If it shall appear from the said certificate of election filed with the clerk of the superior court, that a majority of the votes cast at said election were in favor of the incorporation and that the provisions of law relating to incorporation have been substantially complied with, then the superior court judge shall, by an order in writing entered in the records of the court, duly adjudge and declare that the community in which such election has been held is

and shall be deemed to be a municipal corporation under the name of "the city of (here insert the name)," and the same shall from thenceforth be deemed a municipal corporation possessed of the powers and privileges hereinafter prescribed, and such other powers as may be given by law. Such order shall describe the boundaries and give the name of the corporation, and one certified copy thereof shall be filed in the office of the Secretary of State and another in the office of the magistrate of the district in which the corporation is situated.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
