

viction of a person of a first violation of any provision of this Article or of any federal or state law or regulation for the protection of the sport fish and game of Alaska, the court may, in addition to the penalty imposed by law, revoke the license of such person. Upon subsequent conviction of any such person or any violation of any provisions of this Article or of any federal or state law or regulation for the protection of the sport fish and game of Alaska, the court shall revoke the license of such person, and no person whose license has been so revoked shall purchase another license of the same type for a period of not less than two years or more than three years from the date of such revocation as

determined by the court; provided further, that any licensed guide or assistant guide upon conviction of any provision of any federal or state sport fish, game, or guide law or regulation may have his registered guide license or assistant guide license revoked by the court for any period up to five years. This section shall not be construed so as to divest the Board of Fish and Game of power to revoke, suspend, or refuse issuance of a guide or assistant guide's license in the exercise of its powers of regulation.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 57

AN ACT

Appropriating \$15,000 as a supplemental appropriation for contractual services for the maintenance of airports; and providing for an effective date.

(S.B. 210)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$15,000 is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the Department of Public Works, division of aviation, as a supplemental contractual service appropriation for airport maintenance and snow removal during

fiscal year 1961-62.

Sec. 2. The division of aviation shall submit to the next session of the legislature a full report of expenditures of this account by location and purpose.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 58

AN ACT

Appropriating to the office of the secretary of state for the expense of elections; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 310)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$195,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the office of the secretary of state to cover the costs

of the state primary and general elections to be held in 1962.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
