

driving, written and physical examinations. Such permit shall expire on September 1 of the year following issuance and may be renewed by submission to the department of a current physical examination. The fee for examination and renewal shall be as prescribed hereafter. No person may operate a school bus carrying children who is not in possession of a valid School Bus Driver's Permit. The Commissioner of Public

Safety may establish, by regulation, medical standards and standards of driving conduct and proficiency governing the issuance or denial of school bus driver's permits.

Sec. 2. **Effective Date.** This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 5

AN ACT

Appropriating \$7,000 to the Office of the Governor for the expenses of the Alaska International Development Commission; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 38)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$7,000 is appropriated to the Office of the Governor to

cover expenses of the Alaska International Development Commission.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval, or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 6

AN ACT

Appropriating \$850.00 from the general fund to be paid to John S. Tegtmeier for expenses incurred and damages as a result of injury on Ferry Chilkat ramp; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 33)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. Sum of \$850.00 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse John S. Tegtmeier for damages suffered and expenses incurred as a result of an injury suffered on Ferry Chilkat ramp on July 6, 1959.

Sec. 2. The amount appropriated by this Act shall be paid on vouchers certified by the Governor, upon receipt of a complete release.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

Relating to warrants upon the state treasury, amending Sec. 3, Ch. 130, SLA 1951, as amended by Ch. 128, SLA 1960; and establishing an effective date.
