

CHAPTER 2

AN ACT

Making certain appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 41)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$200 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse Derek Crowell, employee of the Department of Fish and Game, for personal gear lost in line of duty in a fire at Old Andreadfski State Camp on August 10, 1962.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$469.50 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse two full-time employees and the widow of a full-time employee of the Department of Fish and Game for actual losses in line of duty as a result of a United States Navy aircraft crash in October 1961, and a Department of Fish and Game aircraft crash in November 1962, to be disbursed on properly drawn vouchers for the following persons and in the following amounts:

To Loren Croxton	\$111.00
To John Crawford	62.50
To Mrs. Doyle Cisney	296.00

Sec. 3. The sum of \$12.60 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse the Golden Valley Electric Association,

Inc., for power service furnished the Department of Public Safety during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960.

Sec. 4. The sum of \$30 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse the Rabbit Creek Garage for towing services furnished the Department of Public Safety during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959.

Sec. 5. The sum of \$123.25 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse the Firestone Tire and Rubber Co. for tires furnished the Department of Public Safety during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959.

Sec. 6. The sum of \$18.60 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse the International Business Machines Corporation for typewriter repair services furnished the State Superior Court in Fairbanks during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960.

Sec. 7. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 3

AN ACT

Making certain appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 42)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$126 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse Louis A. Weinberg and Emile Weinberg for costs and attorney's fees in accordance with the mandate filed and entered by the State Supreme Court on August 6, 1962, reversing the order of the Superior Court

of the State of Alaska, Fourth Judicial District, at Fairbanks, dismissing petitioner's complaint in Civil Action File No. 61-105.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
