AN ACT

Relating to borrowing money from the United States to complete capital improvements begun prior to the earthquake of March 27, 1964; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. For the purpose of providing funds to complete capital improvements begun, pursuant to Ch. 170, SLA 1960, Ch. 174, SLA 1960, Ch. 121, SLA 1962, Ch. 122, SLA 1962, Ch. 123, SLA 1962, and Ch. 157, SLA 1962, prior to the earthquake of March 27, 1964, the State Bond Committee is hereby authorized to borrow from the United States government, \$7,200,000 as authorized by Section 56, Alaska Omnibus Act of 1964. The State Bond Committee is hereby authorized to issue notes or other obligations for money borrowed and to do all things which in its judgment are necessary to borrow money from the United States government as authorized in this Act.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
