

Sec. 2. Department of Economic Development and Planning. The Department of Economic Development and Planning shall

(1) plan and administer all official state activities leading up to and relating to the 1964-1965 New York World's Fair;

(2) solicit, encourage, and foster participation by Alaska business firms, individuals, and organizations in the Alaska exhibit;

(3) have the power to enter into agreements for use or rental of space within the exhibit building on such terms and conditions as the commissioner of economic development and planning may consider reasonable and consistent with sharing the financial burden to the state of the exhibit;

(4) use its facilities and best efforts to obtain the cooperation and support of individuals, organizations, political subdi-

visions, and business firms in the Alaska exhibit so that the public is fully informed as to the nature of the exhibit;

(5) have the power to hire personnel necessary for staffing the exhibit and for carrying out its duties established by this Act, who shall be in the partially exempt service under AS 39.25.120.

Sec. 3. Department of Public Works. The Department of Public Works shall

(1) investigate and be responsible for the design, construction, maintenance, and destruction of the exhibit building and site improvements;

(2) be responsible for the selection of an Alaska architect;

(3) do all things necessary to the accomplishment of the purpose of this Act.

Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 61

AN ACT

Making and transferring appropriations for the installation of sleeperettes on state ferries; and providing for an effective date.

(H.C.S.S.B. 8)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$250,000 is transferred from the fiscal year 1962-63 appropriation to the Department of Public Works, Division of Marine Transportation, Southeastern Ferry System, to be used for the cost of installing additional sleeperette units on the state ferries constructed or authorized to be constructed for the southeastern ferry system.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Depart-

ment of Public Works, Division of Marine Transportation, to be used for the cost of installing additional sleeperette units on the state ferries constructed or authorized to be constructed for the southeastern ferry system.

Sec. 3. The transfer and appropriation made by this Act are for capital projects and are subject to the provisions of AS 37.25.020.

Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
