

CHAPTER 67

AN ACT

Appropriating \$350,000 to construct and operate an exhibit in the New York World's Fair of 1964-1965; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 193)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska: Fair of 1964-1965.

Section 1. The sum of \$350,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Economic Development and Planning for construction and operation of a state exhibit in the New York World's

Sec. 2. The unused portion of this appropriation shall lapse into the general fund on June 30, 1966.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 68

AN ACT

Appropriating \$2,500 to Benny Benson as an award for designing the Alaska flag; and providing for an effective date.

(C.S.H.B. 203)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska.

Section 1. The sum of \$2,500 is appropriated from the general fund to Benny Benson, designer of Alaska's flag, as an award for designing the flag.

Sec. 2. The amount appropriated by this Act shall be paid on vouchers certified by the governor.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 69

AN ACT

Making certain appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 226)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska.

Section 1. The sum of \$462 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse Al Martin, James Houston, William Davis, Jr., and John G. Martin for costs and attor-

ney fees in accordance with File No. 256, Mandate, issued by the Supreme Court, State of Alaska, March 19, 1963.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
