## AN ACT

Related to hearings under the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Act; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.30.005 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(j) The board may also arrange to have hearings held by the commission, officer, or tribunal having authority to hear cases arising under the workmen's compensation law of any other state, of the District of Columbia, or of any territory of the United States. The testimony and proceedings at the hearing shall be reported to the board and is a part of the record in the case. Evidence taken at the hearing is subject to rebuttal upon final hearing before the board.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
