AN ACT

Relating to the cause for dismissal or nonretention of a teacher; and defining the term "immorality" when used as a cause.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.20.170(1) is amended to read:

(1) incompetency, which is defined as the inability or the unintentional or intentional failure to perform the teacher's customary teaching duties in a satisfactory manner;

* Sec. 2. AS 14.20.170(2) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(2) immorality, which is defined as the commission of an act which, under the laws of the state, constitutes a crime involving moral turpitude; or
