AN ACT

Relating to the transportation of exceptional children to and from school."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.30.347. TRANSPORTATION OF EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN.
When transportation is required to be provided as part of special services, exceptional children, whenever practicable, shall be carried separately from the children attending regular classes. State reimbursement for transportation of exceptional children shall be as provided for transportation of pupils attending regular classes except that eligibility for reimbursement shall not be subject to restriction based on the minimum distance between the school and the residence of the exceptional child.
