## AN ACT

Providing for benefits to workmen suffering permanent total disability under the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Act; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.30.175(b) is amended to read:

(b) In computing compensation for permanent total disability the average weekly wages are considered to have been not more than \$100. If the average weekly wages as computed under sec. 220 of this chapter are less than \$25 a week he shall receive as compensation for permanent total disability his average weekly wages.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1966.
