AN ACT

Amending the provisions of the borough law relating to the relationship between the schools and the borough; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 07.15.330(a) is amended to read:

(a) Each organized borough constitutes a borough school district and the first and second class borough shall establish, maintain, and operate a system of public schools on an areawide basis.

* Sec. 2. AS 07.15.330(d) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(d) The school board shall submit the annual budget for the following school year to the assembly by April 1 for approval of the total amount. Within 30 days after receipt of the budget the assembly shall determine the total amount of money to be made available from local sources for school purposes, and shall furnish the school board with a statement of the sum to be made available. If the assembly does not, within 30 days, furnish the school board with a statement of the sum to be made available, the amount requested in the budget is automatically approved. Not later than May 31, the

assembly shall appropriate the amount to be made available from local sources from money available for the purpose.

* Sec. 3. AS 07.15.330(e) is amended to read:

(e) The assembly shall determine the location of school buildings with due consideration of the recommendations of the borough school board.

* Sec. 4. AS 07.15.330(f) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(f) The school board is responsible for the design criteria of school buildings. Subject to the approval of the assembly, the school board shall select the appropriate professional personnel to develop the designs. The school board shall submit preliminary and subsequent designs for a school building to the assembly for approval or disapproval. If the design is disapproved, a revised design shall be prepared and presented to the assembly.

* Sec. 5. AS 07.15.330(g) is amended to read:

(g) The borough school board shall provide custodial services and routine maintenance for school buildings and shall appoint, compensate, and otherwise control personnel for these purposes. The assembly shall provide for all major rehabilitation, all construction, and major repair of school buildings. The recommendations of the school board shall be considered in carrying out the provisions of this subsection.

* Sec. 6. AS 07.15.330 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(j) The school board is responsible for the appointment, compensation, and control of all school employees and administrative officers in accordance with AS 14.

* Sec. 7. AS 07.30.020(c) is amended to read:

(c) The date of the regular election for the school board is the same as that for the council in the largest first class city within the borough or annually on the first Tuesday of October if there is no first class city within the borough. The term of office for a member of the school board begins on the first Monday following certification of the results of the election.

* Sec. 8. This Act takes effect July 1, 1966.
