AN ACT

An Act prohibiting the littering of highways.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.20.590(b) is amended to read:

(b) No person may put or throw any kind of garbage, rubbish, or material, or abandon animal viscera or other discarded objects on a highway, highway right-of-way, or public recreation facility. No person may put or throw any kind of litter or trash from a highway or highway right-of-way onto private property.

* Sec. 2. AS 19 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

Sec. 19.17.010. POSTING OF LAW. The commissioner of highways shall place a sign near the state boundary at each primary and secondary highway which informs the public of the prohibition against, and penalty for, highway littering and may place similar signs at other locations in the state when considered necessary.
