AN ACT

Relating to the annual license fee of trucks weighing 4,000 pounds or less; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.10.200(b)(4) is amended to read:

(4) for a motor vehicle, including a motor vehicle pulling a trailer or semi-trailer, designed, used, or maintained primarily for the transportation of passengers for hire, excepting taxicabs, and excepting buses taxed under (b)(5) of this section, or for the transportation or hauling of property, including a commercial vehicle such as a trailer, semi-trailer, truck, wrecker, tow car, hearse, ambulance, and tractor, a tax based upon the actual unladen weight as established by the manufacturer's advertised weight, or upon the actual weight which the owner has the responsibility of furnishing, subject to the approval of the commissioner or his agent, as follows:

4,000 pounds or less \$35;
4,001 pounds and not over 12,000 pounds . . 60;
12,001 pounds and not over 18,000 pounds . .110;

18,001 pounds and over 160;

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect February 15, 1966.
