## AN ACT

Relating to offenses against civil rights.

---

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 11.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

Sec. 11.60.280. CONSPIRACY AGAINST RIGHTS OF PERSONS.

A person who conspires with another to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate a person because that person seeks to exercise or enjoy, or has exercised or enjoyed a right, privilege or immunity granted by the constitution or the laws of this state is guilty of a felony and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not more than two years, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both.

Sec. 11.60.290. DEPRIVATION OF RIGHTS UNDER COLOR OF LAW. A person who, under color of any law, ordinance or regulation of this state or its political subdivisions, wilfully deprives another person of a right, privilege or immunity granted by the constitution or the laws of this state, or who subjects another person to different punishments,

pains or penalties because of that person's race, color, creed or national origin, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both.
