AN ACT

Relating to judicial review for teachers nonretained by an employer.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.20.205, as enacted by CS for House Bill No. 12 of the Fourth State Legislature, is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.205. JUDICIAL REVIEW. If a school board or appeal panel reaches a decision unfavorable to a teacher, the teacher is entitled to a de novo trial in the superior court. However, a teacher who has not attained tenure rights but who has, upon nonretention, requested a hearing is not entitled to judicial review according to this section.

* Sec. 2. This Act amends CS for House Bill No. 12 of the Fourth State Legislature and takes effect if and when that bill becomes law.
