AN ACT

Relating to notices of abandoned vehicles.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.30.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 28.30.020. CUSTODIAN OF VEHICLE TO NOTIFY OWNER AND LIEN HOLDER. If the record of registration or ownership of the vehicle is in the state, the officer into whose custody the vehicle is delivered shall give notice by certified mail to the registered and legal owner and to the holder of a lien or encumbrance on the vehicle that the vehicle has been found. If the record of registered or legal ownership is in another state or territory, the officer shall send the notice to the official in charge of registration or ownership certificates in that state or territory.
