## AN ACT

Relating to the organization and employment of the State Militia;  
and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 26.05.100 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 26.05.100. STATE MILITIA. A state militia may be organized through voluntary enlistments under regulations as to discipline and training which may be prescribed by the governor. During the time that the Alaska National Guard, or any part of it, is not available to the state by reason of active federal service, or the National Guard requires augmentation to perform its state mission, the governor may activate the state militia.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
