AN ACT

Relating to the minimum salary scale for teachers; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.20.220 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.220. MINIMUM TEACHERS' SALARY SCALE BY AREA. (a) The school board of each school district in the Southeastern area shall pay a regularly qualified teacher employed by it a salary not less than that set out in this subsection.

(1) The base salary of a teacher with three years' training is \$5,000 for a teacher with no public school experience in the state. The salary is augmented by \$200 for each year of public school experience in the state up to and including four years.

(2) The base salary for a teacher holding a bachelor's degree and having the requisite number of hours in education is \$6,000. This salary is augmented by the sum of .04 times the base for each year of public school experience in the state up to and including eight years.

(3) The base salary for a teacher having a master's degree and the required number of hours of education is \$6,500. This salary is augmented by the sum of .04 times the base for each year of teaching experience in the state up to and including 12 years.

(b) The school board of each school district in the Southcentral area shall pay the amount set out in (a) of this section plus \$300.

(c) The school board of each school district in the Central area and that part of the Southcentral area lying west of 152⁰ West Longitude shall pay the amount set out in (a) of this section plus \$700.

(d) The department, as the operating agency of schools outside school districts, shall pay a regularly qualified teacher employed by the state a salary of not less than \$500 a year plus the usual housing allowance above the salary established by (a), (b), (c), (f) or (g) of this section, with an increment of \$300 for a bachelor's degree plus 18 hours training, and an equal increment of \$300 for a master's degree plus 18 hours training. However, in the state-operated schools, instead of augmenting the base salary by .04, each salary shall be augmented by .05 times the base for each year of public school experience in the state up to and including eight years for teachers with a bachelor's degree, 10 years for teachers with a bachelor's degree plus 18 hours of training, 12 years for teachers with a master's degree, and 14 years for teachers with a master's degree plus 18 hours of training.

(e) Not more than four years of public school experience outside the state may be substituted for a like period

of public school experience in the state when a teacher's position on the salary scale is established.

(f) The school board of each school district in the Northwest area shall pay the amount set out in (a) of this section plus \$1,200.

(g) The school board of each school district in the Southeast area shall pay the amount set out in (a) of this section plus \$200.

* Sec. 2. AS 14.20.230 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.230. SUPERINTENDENTS' SALARIES. The school boards of school districts and the department as the operating agency for schools outside school districts shall pay a regularly qualified superintendent a salary not less than the allowable base for his position on the teacher's scale provided in sec. 220(a)-(g) of this chapter, plus

(1) 20 per cent of the base for a superintendent of a district or state school with an average daily membership of less than 500;

(2) 25 per cent of the base for a superintendent of a district or state school with an average daily membership of 500 or more.

* Sec. 3. AS 14.20.240 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.240. SALARIES OF PRINCIPALS AND VICE PRINCIPALS. The school boards of school districts and the department as the operating agency for schools outside districts shall pay each regularly qualified principal and vice principal a salary not less than the allowable base for his position on the teachers' scale provided in sec. 220(a)-(g) of this chapter, plus

- (1) 15 per cent of the base for a principal;
- (2) 10 per cent of the base for a vice principal.

* Sec. 4. AS 14.20.245 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.245. SALARIES OF OTHER ADMINISTRATORS. The school boards of school districts and the department as the operating agency for schools outside districts shall pay a regularly qualified administrator for whom certification is required, other than a superintendent, assistant superintendent, principal, or vice principal, a salary not less than the allowable base for his position on the teachers' scale provided in sec. 220(a)-(g) of this chapter plus 15 per cent of the base.

* Sec. 5. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.20.275. DEFINITIONS. In sec. 220 of this chapter

(1) "Central area" means that area included within the boundaries of election districts 13, 14, 15, and 16;

(2) "Northwest area" means that area included within the boundaries of election districts 17, 18, and 19;

(3) "Southcentral area" means that area included within the boundaries of election districts 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12;

(4) "Southeastern area" means that area included within the boundaries of election districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

* Sec. 6. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1966.
