AN ACT

Eliminating a conflict in the procedure for distributing absentee ballots; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 15.20.130 is amended to read:

Sec. 15.20.130. PROCEDURE ON APPLICATION BY MAIL.

After receipt of an application by mail for an absentee ballot, the secretary of state, or the district or deputy magistrate, shall airmail to the applicant the ballot and other absentee voting material when they are ready for distribution, if the application includes the name and both the present address and the full local resident address of the applicant. The larger envelope to be used for returning the absentee ballot to the election officials shall be addressed to the election supervisor in the district in which the voter is a resident.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
