

CHAPTER 23

AN ACT

Providing that licenses for commercial fishing obtained upon false application are void and providing criminal penalties for falsification of license applications; and providing for an effective date.

(S.B. 68)

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 16.05.665. **Falsification of Application for License.** (a) A person who knowingly makes a false statement as to a material fact on an application for a license under secs. 440-660 of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both.

(b) A license issued under secs. 440-660 of this chapter to a person convicted under (a) of this section is void.

(c) A person whose license is void under (a) and (b) of this section may not obtain another license of the same type for a period of not less than two nor more than three years from the date of conviction by the court.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval, or on the day it becomes law without such approval.

CHAPTER 24

AN ACT

Relating to compensation for serious disfigurement; and providing for an effective date.

(H.B. 86)

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Alaska:

Section 1. AS 23.30.190(19) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(19) in addition to other allowable compensation, the board shall award proper and equitable compensation up to \$3,500 for serious disfigurement of

face, head and, when such disfigurement is likely to handicap the employee in securing or holding employment, for serious disfigurement of neck or limbs normally exposed;

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
