## AN ACT

Relating to the Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act; providing an exception to the Act for a person driving a vehicle belonging to his employer.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 28.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

**Sec. 28.20.325. EXCEPTION FOR BUSINESS RELATIONSHIP.**

If the driver at the time of an accident was driving, in the course and scope of his employment, a vehicle owned, operated or leased by his employer, the security deposit, proof of future responsibility and suspension provisions of this chapter apply to the employer and to the vehicles owned by him or registered under his name and do not apply to the driver.
