AN ACT

Making certain appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$598.33 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse Ernest Rosendale for his deposit in the Miners and Merchants Bank of Ketchikan which the state took by escheat.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$771.42 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse Casper Rosendale for his deposit in the Miners and Merchants Bank of Ketchikan which the state took by escheat.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
