AN ACT

Relating to the liability of a homestead for the debts of either or both of the tenants by the entirety.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 34.15.140(b) is amended to read:

(b) A homestead to the value of \$8,000 held by tenants by the entirety is not liable for the debts of either or of both tenants, except by special agreement. An estate, other than a homestead held by tenants by the entirety, is liable for the debts of either or both tenants.
