## AN ACT

Relating to notice of hearing on the final account in probate proceedings; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 13.30.710(a) is amended to read:

(a) When the estate is fully administered, it is the duty of the executor or administrator to file his final account except in a nonintervention will when no order requires the filing of a final account as set out in sec. 111 of this chapter. The account shall be verified and contain a detailed statement of the amount of money received and expended by him, from whom received and to whom paid, and refer to the vouchers for payments, and the amount of money and property remaining unexpended or unappropriated. Upon the filing of the final account, the judge shall make an order setting the time and place for hearing objections to the final account, and directing notice of hearing to be given by publishing the order one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the judicial district, and posting notices in three public places in the judicial district at

least 30 days before the date set for the hearing.

\* Sec. 2. This Act shall apply to all estates pending on the effective date of this Act if the final account has not been filed.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
