## AN ACT

Relating to property exempt from execution.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 09.35.080(1) is amended to read:

(1) the income of the judgment debtor which is due to him or received by him from any source at any time within 30 days immediately preceding the levy, but not exceeding \$350 if he is the head of a family, and the amount of \$200 if he is a single man, and when it appears by the debtor's affidavit or otherwise that the income is necessary for his use or for the use of his family which is supported in whole or in part by his income;

\* Sec. 2. AS 09.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 09.35.085. EXEMPTION FOR CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENTS.  
In addition to the exemptions set out in sec. 80 of this chapter, the amount which the judgment debtor has been ordered to pay to a court trustee as child support payments under Rule 67 of the Rules of Civil Procedure is exempt from execution.
