AN ACT

Extending the preference right application deadline for occupants of tide or submerged land not seaward of home rule or first class cities; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 38.05.320(c)(3) is amended to read:

(3) The preference rights hereinabove granted any occupant in (c) of this section is lost unless the occupant of tide or submerged land not seaward of a home rule or first class city makes application to the director to exercise such preference right by July 1, 1967.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
