AN ACT

Relating to the Alaska State Office in the Far East; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.19.640 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.19.640. ALASKA STATE OFFICE CREATED. There is created within the Office of the Governor an Alaska State Office to be opened and maintained in Tokyo, Japan, as an outlet for economic development, resource, and trade information, and as a contact point for government and private industry of Alaska and the Far East in promoting and carrying on trade between the state and the Far East.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
