AN ACT

Authorizing the division of lands, Department of Natural Resources to zone lands in the unorganized borough to facilitate federal land sales.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 07.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 07.05.040. ZONING IN THE UNORGANIZED BOROUGH.

(a) In areas of the unorganized borough where there is no political subdivision of the state with a zoning power, the division of lands, Department of Natural Resources, shall exercise the zoning power by adopting zoning regulations.

(b) The division of lands, Department of Natural Resources, shall exercise its zoning power within federal lands in the unorganized borough, only at the times and in the areas it is requested to do so by the Secretary of the Interior to facilitate sales of federal lands within the unorganized borough under Public Law 88-608, 78 Stat. 988.

(c) Any zoning done by the division of lands, Department of Natural Resources, under (b) of this section, is final unless disapproved by concurrent resolution at the

next regular session of the legislature.
