AN ACT

Making certain appropriations for claims arising from prior years; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$5,506.04 is appropriated from the general fund to pay Robert E. Sheldon for retired benefits due under the provisions of ch. 102, SLA 1951, withheld during 1959 and 1960.

* Sec. 2. The sum of \$26 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse the Anchorage Times Publishing Co. for advertising , furnished the Department of Administration in fiscal year 1963-64.

* Sec. 3. The sum of \$453.72 is appropriated from the general fund for payment to Robert G. Langberg for wages due from September, 1961.

* Sec. 4. The sum of \$15,306 is appropriated from the general fund to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough to recover the proceeds of state sales of borough selected lands in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964.

* Sec. 5. The sum of \$300 is appropriated from the general fund to reimburse Mrs. Edgar Tweet for property reclaimed in 1961.

* Sec. 6. The sum of \$1,160.25 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Revenue for the purchase of stale date warrants.

* Sec. 7. The sum of \$3,500 is appropriated from the general fund to Al Moseley for damage caused to his aircraft at the Fairbanks International Airport.

* Sec. 8. The sum of \$8,330 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education for reimbursement to the federal government for audit exceptions taken during 1959-1962.

* Sec. 9. The sum of \$350 is appropriated from the general fund to Alfred J. Opland to rectify an error in a teaching contract for fiscal year 1957-58.

* Sec. 10. The sum of \$9,700 is appropriated from the Sick and Disabled Fishermen's Fund to Dr. Jack W. Clarke in payment for medical services rendered in 1960-1962 to various persons under AS 23.35.

* Sec. 11. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
