AN ACT

Establishing a penalty for injuring boundary monuments, light posts, protective railings, state-erected signs, or historical monuments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.20.580 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(b) A person who is convicted of violating this section is punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$500, or by both.

* Sec. 2. AS 11.20.590(d) is amended to read:

(d) A person who wilfully violates a subsection of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment in jail for not more than one year, or by both.
