AN ACT

Appropriating for the cost of constructing and completing the Bear Creek trapping facility in 1964; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$1,218 is appropriated from the general fund to compensate James Cameron, a contractor, for the additional labor and materials required after the March 27, 1964 earthquake to complete performance of state contract No. P-135 covering the construction and completion of the Bear Creek trapping facility near Seward during the summer of 1964.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
