AN ACT

Relating to the power of first class and home rule cities and organized boroughs to punish for ordinance violations; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 29.10.195(a) is amended to read:

(a) The council may prescribe the punishment for the violation of any ordinance, but the punishment shall not exceed a fine of \$300 or imprisonment in a city jail for 30 days, or both, together with the costs of prosecution. However, the punishment authorized under this subsection may be imposed only if the ordinance is codified and copies of the ordinance are made available to the public.

* Sec. 2. AS 29.08 is amended by adding a new section to read:

ARTICLE 2. GENERAL POWERS.

Sec. 29.08.200. LIMIT ON HOME RULE POWER TO PUNISH ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS. A home rule city may not impose criminal penalties for the violation of a general ordinance unless the ordinance is codified and copies of the ordinance are made available to the public.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 1967.
