## AN ACT

Relating to the practice of optometry in the state.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 08.72.140 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.72.140. QUALIFICATIONS FOR EXAMINATION. The board shall admit to the examination a person who furnishes proof that

- (1) he is at least 21 years of age and of good character;
- (2) he has normal color perception and a visual acuity of a standard known as 20/40 in at least one eye;
- (3) he is not afflicted with a contagious or infectious disease;
- (4) he has had education equivalent to four years attendance at a state high school;
- (5) he is a graduate of a recognized school or college of optometry.

\* Sec. 2. AS 08.72.300 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(4) "lenses" means conventional or contact lenses.
