HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 20

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting a study and report
on highway connections for
Revillagigedo, Pennock, Gravina,
and Annette Islands.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Island of Revillagigedo has no highway connection with the adjoining islands of Pennock, Gravina, and Annette; and

WHEREAS there is a strong community of interest between the City of Ketchikan and its environs and the City of Metlakatla and Annette Island; and

WHEREAS a highway connection between Ketchikan and the Annette Island airport would greatly facilitate air travel there and generally facilitate the economic well-being of the entire area;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the Department of Highways to arrange at once for a study of the need for and benefits and costs of a highway connection for Revillagigedo, Pennock, Gravina, and Annette Islands and to report its findings and recommendations to the Fifth Legislature in January, 1967.
