HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 21

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting early action re-  
garding the planning for and  
construction of the Stikine  
River access road to Canada.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS access to the Continental United States from Southeastern Alaska by road has been a long-standing and long-recognized need; and

WHEREAS there have been two major studies of the highway and highway access problems of Alaska during the past 10 years, the report of the International Rail and Highway Commission and the "Highway Need Study Program"; and

WHEREAS both of these reports indicate the need for and feasibility of an access road up the valley of the Stikine River to connect with the Canadian road system;

BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested to apply all the energy and facilities of his office to accomplish the necessary planning and other action for the early construction of the access road up the valley of the Stikine River in order that Southeastern Alaska can be connected with the highways leading to the Continental United States.
