HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the construction  
of additional marine facilities  
at Myers Chuck.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Myers Chuck is an important marine and fishing center strategically located between Ketchikan and Wrangell; and

WHEREAS a great number of boats use the facilities at Myers Chuck both during the fishing season and during the off season; and

WHEREAS during adverse weather conditions boats using the facilities at Myers Chuck are endangered due to the turbulent waters in Clarence Straights;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works is urged to install an additional 400 lineal feet of float and moorage space at Myers Chuck; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Public Works is urged to construct a suitable protective log breakwater for the additional protection of the many boats which use the facilities at Myers Chuck.
