HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 32

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to efforts to have the
Babe Ruth World Series held in
Fairbanks in 1967.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the youth of Alaska are our greatest natural resource;
and

WHEREAS the activities of Babe Ruth Baseball, Inc. in Alaska
have played a considerable role in developing our youth as
citizens of the future; and

WHEREAS the Alaska Babe Ruth Baseball organization is at-
tempting to have the 1967 Babe Ruth World Series held at Fairbanks
during Alaska's centennial year; and

WHEREAS the holding of this national event at Fairbanks
during 1967 will enhance the observance of the Alaska Purchase
Centennial and bring Alaska additional national recognition;

BE IT RESOLVED that the legislature endorses the efforts of
the State Babe Ruth Baseball organization and joins with it in
inviting Babe Ruth Baseball, Inc. to hold the national Babe Ruth
World Series in Fairbanks, Alaska in 1967.
