HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 41

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the collecting and  
displaying of group photographs  
of members of past Territorial  
Legislatures.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the 1965 renovation of the halls and quarters of the Legislature in the capitol has been a marked change and improvement in legislative working conditions and facilities; and

WHEREAS many members of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska contributed much to the welfare of Alaska and to the movement for Alaska statehood which made having a Legislature of the State of Alaska possible;

BE IT RESOLVED that in order to help preserve some of the legislative history, memories and traditions of the past Alaska Territorial Legislature, the Legislative Council is instructed to collect wherever available group pictures of all past Territorial Legislatures, both Senate and House since 1913, and to suitably prepare and display such photographic records with appropriate identification affixed thereto upon the walls of the legislators' lounge.
