HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 59

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Relating to the grant of construction funds from the Hill-Harris program to Wesleyan Hospital.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Wesleyan Hospital for Chronic Diseases, a private hospital located in the City of Seward, has applied for a matching construction grant from the Hill-Harris program in order to build a long-term care facility; and

WHEREAS the administrator of Wesleyan Hospital believes that it is not economically feasible for the hospital to continue to serve only tuberculosis patients; and

WHEREAS the City of Seward, by City Council Resolution No. 509 adopted March 21, 1966, has endorsed and approved the application of Wesleyan Hospital for matching funds from the Hill-Harris program with which to construct an additional wing to care for long-term, chronic disease patients;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Health Facilities Council of the Alaska Department of Health and Welfare is urged and requested to grant a high priority to the application of Wesleyan Hospital for a matching funds grant from the Hill-Harris program in order that construction of the additional hospital wing may begin before the end of this year's construction season.
