Relating to extending ferry
service for southeastern
Alaska communities.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the welfare and the economy of many southeastern Alaska communities are adversely affected by the relative isolation of these communities; and

WHEREAS the well-being of the state is especially dependent on the vitality and strength of these communities; and

WHEREAS the state ferry system has proven to be an effective means of minimizing the effects of isolation in some communities of southeastern Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to extend, wherever practicable, ferry service to communities in southeastern Alaska which are currently without ferry service.
