JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to increased mail service for the Alaska Peninsula, Northwest Alaska and Aleutian Islands chain, including the Pribilof Islands, and the establishment of a post office at Nelson Lagoon.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS increased mail service is necessary for the more remote areas of the state located on the Alaska Peninsula and the Aleutian Islands chain, including the Pribilof Islands; and

WHEREAS increased mail service to those areas of the state requires that air schedules for delivery of mail be maintained when weather permits and not be interrupted by charter flights or other air business; and

WHEREAS there is a need for the establishment of a post office at Nelson Lagoon;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Postmaster General is respectfully urged to establish a post office at Nelson Lagoon and to authorize improved mail service to the Alaska Peninsula, Northwest Alaska and the Aleutian Islands chain, including the Pribilof Islands, in a manner that will permit regular air schedules for delivery of mail to be maintained when weather permits and without interruption by air charter requirements or other air

business.
